ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. The Fruit Packing Houses Employees (State) Conciliation Committee published 28 August 1954 (114 I.G. 388), as varied, be dissolved.

2. There be established a new Fruit Packing Houses Employees (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

Employees employed in or in connection with the receiving, grading, sorting, wrapping, packing and despatching of fruit in and from packing houses in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna, excepting employees employed in rural industries within the meaning of Section 5(4) of the *Industrial Relations Act* 1991.

3. The said committee shall consist of one representative of employers and one representative of employees.

4. The representative of employers shall be appointed upon nomination as prescribed by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales.

5. The representative of employees shall be appointed upon nomination as prescribed by The Australian Workers' Union, New South Wales Branch.

6 This order shall take effect on and from 9 February 1993.
