ORDER

The Commission orders that —

- 1. The Laundry Employees (State) Conciliation Committee published 31 May 1932 (41 I.G. 818), as varied, be dissolved.
- 2. There be established a new Laundry Employees (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of $\,$

Laundry employees, including employees engaged in sorting and/or packing laundry in the employ of an employer providing laundry services in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna;

excepting —

Engine drivers and firemen, greasers, trimmers, cleaners, and pumpers engaged in or about the driving of engines, and electrical crane, winch and motor drivers; and

Carters, grooms, stablemen, yardmen and drivers of motor and other power-propelled vehicles;

excepting also employees of —

The Council of the City of Sydney;

The Council of the City of Newcastle;

and excepting also all persons employed in or in connection with hospitals, insane asylums, public charitable institutions or ambulance work.

- 3. The said committee shall consist of one representative of employers and one representative of employees.
- 4. The representative of employers shall be appointed upon nomination as prescribed by Textiles Rental and Laundry Association (New South Wales);
- 5. The representative of employees shall be appointed upon nomination as prescribed by The Australian Workers' Union, New South Wales Branch.
- 6. This order shall take effect on and from 25 November 1992.
