**MEAT PRESERVERS, &c. (STATE) CONCILIATION COMMITTEE**

INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS COMMISSION OF NEW SOUTH WALES

Application by The Australasian Meat Industry Employees' Union, Newcastle and Northern Branch, industrial organisation of employees.

**ORDER**

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Meat Preservers, &c. (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

Employees in meat, game and/or rabbit preserving works; and boners and slicers for export and/or for any other purpose in any establishment other than smallgoods factories, abattoirs, meat works and slaughterhouses in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna;

*excepting* —

Employees of the Riverstone Meat Company Proprietary Limited at Riverstone;  
Employees engaged in the manufacture of margarine;  
Butchers (other than boners and slicers);  
Carters, grooms, stablemen, yardmen, drivers of motor or other power-propelled vehicles, and extra hands; and  
Engine drivers, firemen, greasers, trimmers, cleaners and pumpers engaged in or about the driving of engines; and electrical crane, winch and motor drivers.

2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.

3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, two by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales.

4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The Australasian Meat Industry Employees' Union, New South Wales Branch.
5. This order shall take effect on and from 7 April 1993.
