## **ORDER**

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Crown Employees (Skilled Tradesmen) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

All persons employed by the Crown, including employees of any person or corporation employing persons on behalf of the Government of the State of New South Wales, permanent and temporary, whether employed under the *Public Sector Management Act* 1988, or otherwise, engaged as:

Sydney Harbour Bridge Employees;

Public Hospital (Skilled Tradesmen).

- 2. The said committee shall consist of two members representing the employers and two members representing the employees, with a Conciliation Commissioner as Chairperson.
- 3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Public Employment Industrial Relations Authority.
- 4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, jointly by the Building Workers' Industrial Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch, and the Electrical Trades Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch.
- 5. Where a matter before the Conciliation Committee concerns only rates of pay or conditions of employment of the New South Wales TAFE Commission, the said organisation shall have alternate nominating rights to sit as a member of the Conciliation Committee in place of the member appointed upon the nomination of the Public Employment Industrial Relations Authority.
- 6. Where a matter before the Conciliation Committee concerns only rates of pay or conditions of employment of the Roads and Traffic Authority, the said organisation shall have alternate nominating rights to sit as a member of the Conciliation Committee in place of the member appointed upon the nomination of the Public Employment Industrial Relations Authority.
- 7. Where a matter before the Conciliation Committee concerns only rates of pay or conditions of employment of the Water Resources Commission, the said organisation shall have alternate nominating rights to sit as a member of the Conciliation Committee in place of the member appointed upon the nomination of the Public Employment Industrial Relations Authority.
- 8. Where a matter before the Conciliation Committee concerns only rates of pay or conditions of employment of the Maritime Services Board, the said organisation shall have alternate

nominating rights to sit as a member of the Conciliation Committee in place of the member appointed upon the nomination of the Public Employment Industrial Relations Authority.

- 9. Where a matter before the Conciliation Committee concerns only rates of pay or conditions of employment of employees who are members of the Furnishing Trades Society of New South Wales, the said organisation shall have alternate nominating rights to sit as a member of the Conciliation Committee in place of the member appointed upon the joint nomination of the Building Workers' Industrial Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch, and the Electrical Trades Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch.
- 10. Where a matter before the Conciliation Committee concerns only rates of pay or conditions of employment of employees who are members of The New South Wales Branch of the Vehicle Builders' Employees Federation of Australia, the said organisation shall have alternate nominating rights to sit as a member of the Conciliation Committee in place of the member appointed upon the joint nomination of the Building Workers' Industrial Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch, and the Electrical Trades Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch.
- 11. Where a matter before the Conciliation Committee concerns only rates of pay or conditions of employment of employees who are members of the Australasian Society of Engineers, the said organisation shall have alternate nominating rights to sit as a member of the Conciliation Committee in place of the member appointed upon the joint nomination of the Building Workers' Industrial Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch, and the Electrical Trades Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch.
- 12. Where a matter before the Conciliation Committee concerns only rates of pay or conditions of employment of employees who are members of the Public Service Association of New South Wales, the said organisation shall have alternate nominating rights to sit as a member of the Conciliation Committee in place of the member appointed upon the joint nomination of the Building Workers' Industrial Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch, and the Electrical Trades Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch.
- 13. Where a matter before the Conciliation Committee concerns only rates of pay or conditions of employment of the members appointed upon the nomination of the Public Works Department, the said organisation shall have alternate nominating rights to sit as a member of the Conciliation Committee in place of the member appointed upon the nomination of the Public Employment Industrial Relations Authority.
- 14. Where a matter before the Conciliation Committee concerns only rates of pay or conditions of employment of employees who are members of the Metals and Engineering Workers' Union, the said organisation shall have alternate nominating rights to sit as a member of the Conciliation Committee in place of the member appointed upon the joint nomination of the Building Workers' Industrial Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch, and the Electrical Trades Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch.

- 15. Where a matter before the Conciliation Committee concerns only rates of pay or conditions of employment of employees who are members of The Operative Painters and Decorators' Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch, the said organisation shall have alternate nominating rights to sit as a member of the Conciliation Committee in place of the member appointed upon the joint nomination of the Building Workers' Industrial Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch, and the Electrical Trades Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch.
- 16. Where a matter before the Conciliation Committee concerns only rates of pay or conditions of employment of employees who are members of The New South Wales Plumbers and Gasfitters Employees' Union, the said organisation shall have alternate nominating rights to sit as a member of the Conciliation Committee in place of the member appointed upon the joint nomination of the Building Workers' Industrial Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch, and the Electrical Trades Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch.
- 17. Where a matter before the Conciliation Committee concerns only rates of pay or conditions of employment of employees who are members of The Australian Services Union, New South Wales Branch Transport and Information Technology Branch, the said organisation shall have alternate nominating rights to sit as a member of the Conciliation Committee in place of the member appointed upon the joint nomination of the Building Workers' Industrial Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch, and the Electrical Trades Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch.
- 18. This order shall take effect on and from 31 March 1993.
