Application by The Australian Workers' Union, New South Wales Branch, industrial organisation of employees.

ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a New Pest Control Industry (State) Conciliation Committee for the industry and callings of — all employees engaged in the operations of fumigating shops, factories, offices, houses and furniture or engaged in pest exterminating in connection therewith if work incidental to such fumigating and pest exterminating in the State.
2. The said Committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.
3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, two by the Employers' Federation of New South Wales.
4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, two by the Australian Workers' Union, New South Wales Branch.
5. This order shall take effect on and from 7 December 1993.
