ORDER

The Commission orders that ----

1. There be established a new Private Pathology Laboratories (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

All persons employed in or in connection with approved pathology authorities (other than State or public authorities) or their associated or accredited pathology laboratories as defined by the *Health Insurance Act* 1973 (as at 18 March 1994) in the State of New South Wales, excluding the County of Yancowinna;

excepting --

employees employed by Universities;

and excepting also employees within the jurisdiction of the following Conciliation Committees -

Clerks (State); Private Hospital and Day Procedure Centres Employees' (State);

and excepting also employees within the jurisdiction of the Private Hospitals and Day Procedure Centres, Nursing Homes, &c., Other Than in Hospitals, &c. (State) Conciliation Committee as constituted 31 March 1993.

2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.

3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by Australian Industrial Relations Pty Limited, and one by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales.

4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union, New South Wales Branch.

5. This order shall take effect on and from 18 March 1994.
