ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Public Hospitals Professional and Associated Staff (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

Persons employed in public hospitals in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna, in any of the following callings or avocations, who hold qualifications appropriate to their callings or avocation or who are employed as trainees while pursuing a course of study leading to such qualifications;

Research officers, speech therapists (or speech pathologists), occupational therapists, dietitians, social workers, registered dentists, registered optometrists, medical record librarians (or administrators), physiotherapists, biomedical engineers, psychologists, audiologists, music therapists, librarians, welfare officers, health education officers, alcoholism counsellors, nurse counsellors, chiropodists (or podiatrists);

Persons who are engaged or usually engaged in the callings or avocations whether as assistant or principal employees in training as school dental therapists, dental chairside assistants or dental technicians in a public hospital or by an organisation registered or exempt from registration under the *Charitable Collections Act* 1934, or public dental clinic;

excepting -

Registered medical practitioners employed in any of the abovementioned callings or avocations;

Employees within the jurisdiction of the Crown Employees (United Dental Hospital of Sydney) Conciliation Committee.

2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.

3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination, by the Health Administration Corporation.

4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Public Service Association of New South Wales.

5. This order shall take effect on and from 8 February 1995.
