## ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Medical Officers, Hospital Resident Medical Officers (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

All medical practitioners employed as resident medical officers in or by public hospitals in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna, and excepting employees within the jurisdiction of the Medical Officers, Hospital Specialists Conciliation Committee, and the Medical Officers, Hospital Superintendents, &c. (State) Conciliation Committee.

2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.

3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Health Administration Corporation.

4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Public Service Association of New South Wales.

5. This order shall take effect on and from 8 February 1995.
