ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Charitable Institutions (Professional Social Workers) (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

All persons employed as professional social workers by a charity. Charity means any organisation or association established for or which has as one of its objects a charitable purpose, but shall not include Catholic schools or colleges owned and operated by a Catholic Diocese, Catholic religious order, Catholic parish or incorporated Catholic school/college.

Charitable purpose includes any benevolent or philanthropic purpose.

2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.

3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales, and one by the Aged Services Association of N. S. W.

The following employer organisations shall have alternate nominating rights as prescribed: one by the Catholic Hierarchy of NSW, Province of Sydney, and one by the Extended Care Industry Industrial Secretariat, New South Wales Branch.

4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by the Public Service Association of New South Wales and one by the Australian Services Union of N.S.W.

5. This order shall take effect on and from 22 May 1995.
