ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Cleaning Contractors (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of \longrightarrow

All persons employed by cleaning contractors in the State of New South Wales on cleaning work of any description and/or in property maintenance services;

excepting employees within the jurisdiction of the Clerks (State) Conciliation Committee.

- 2. The said committee shall consist of three representatives of employers and three representatives of employees.
- 3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, two by the Australian Building Services Association and one by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales. The Chamber of Manufactures of New South Wales shall have alternate nominating rights as to one.
- 4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union, New South Wales Branch.
- 5. This order shall take effect on and from 1 September 1995.
