**CORKS AND CORK PRODUCTS MANUFACTURE (STATE)
CONCILIATION COMMITTEE**

ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Corks and Cork Products Manufacture (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

All persons employed in the manufacture of corks and cork products in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna;

excepting —

Engine drivers, firemen, greasers, trimmers, cleaners and pumpers, engaged in or about the driving of engines, and electrical crane, winch and motor drivers;

Carters, grooms, stablemen, yardmen, and drivers of motor and other power-propelled vehicles;

Engineers, fitters, turners, blacksmiths, coppersmiths, patternmakers and their assistants;

Boilermakers and their assistants; and

Moulders and their assistants.

2. The said committee shall consist of one representative of employers and one representative of employees.

3. The representative of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Chamber of Manufactures of New South Wales.

4. The representative of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union, New South Wales Branch.

5. This order shall take effect on and from 1 September 1995.
