ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Domestic Workers, &c. (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of — $\,$

All persons employed in or in connection with domestic work or domestic workers other than persons employed performing clerical work;

excepting all persons employed in or in connection with hospitals, mental hospitals, public charitable institutions or ambulance work;

and excepting employees within the jurisdiction of the following Conciliation Committees:

Cleaning Contractors (State);

Colleges of Advanced Education Employees (State);

Crown Employees (General);

Independent Schools and Colleges, General Non-Teaching Staff, &c. (State);

Kindergartens, &c. (State);

Security and Cleaning, &c. (State);

University Employees (State).

- 2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.
- 3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales and one by the Public Employment Industrial Relations Authority.

- 4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union, New South Wales Branch.
- 5. This order shall take effect on and from 1 September 1995.
