ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Gelatine and Glue Industry, &c. (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

All persons employed in or in connection with the manufacture of glue, gelatine, agar and adhesives in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna;

excepting carters, grooms, stablemen, yardmen and drivers of motor or other power-propelled vehicles; engine drivers, firemen, greasers, trimmers and pumpers, engaged in or about the driving of engines; and electrical crane, winch and motor drivers; employees in abattoirs, meat works, slaughterhouses and meat preserving works;

and excepting also employees within the jurisdiction of the Bituminous Materials Manufacture, &c. (State) Conciliation Committee.

2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.

3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales and one by the Chamber of Manufactures of New South Wales.

4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union, New South Wales Branch.

5. This order shall take effect on and from 1 September 1995.
