ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Paint Industry (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

All persons employed in or in connection with the manufacture (including associated laboratory activities), processing, treatment, handling, distributing (but not retailing) or storage of materials or products used in or in connection with decorative or protective surface coatings or coverings and associated products;

excepting —

Carters, grooms, stablemen, yardmen and drivers of motor and other power-propelled vehicles;

Engine drivers and firemen, greasers, trimmers, cleaners and pumpers engaged in or about the driving of engines, electrical and oil-driven cranes (including mobile cranes), winch and motor drivers;

excepting also employees of The Council of the City of Sydney;

and excepting further all employees within the jurisdiction of the Wire Netting Makers, &c. (Lysaghts) Conciliation Committee.

2. The said committee shall consist of one representative of employers and one representative of employees.

3. The representative of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales.

4. The representative of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union, New South Wales Branch.

5. This order shall take effect on and from 1 September 1995.
