## ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Insulation Materials Manufacture (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

All persons employed in or in connection with the manufacture of insulation materials and products and all persons employed in the installation of such materials and products;

excepting employees within the jurisdiction of the Carters, &c. (State) Conciliation Committee.

2. The said committee shall consist of three representatives of employers and three representatives of employees.

3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales, one by ACM, New South Wales Branch, and one by CSR Limited.

4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union, New South Wales Branch.

5. This order shall take effect on and from 1 September 1995.
