ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Health, Physical Culture and Weight Loss Centres Employees (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

All persons employed as instructors, masseurs, attendants, counsellors or advisers in health and physical culture studios or health advisory or weight loss centres.

- 2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.
- 3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales and one by the Chamber of Manufactures of New South Wales.
- 4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union, New South Wales Branch.
- 5. This order shall take effect on and from 1 September 1995.
