## **ORDER**

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Independent Schools and Colleges General Staff (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

All persons employed as domestic staff, groundpersons, yardpersons, and all other general and maintenance staff (excluding clerical assistants) in denominational or educational schools and colleges other than agricultural colleges established pursuant to the *Education Reform Act* 1990 and in hostels accommodating pupils, students or staff attending any of such establishments in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna;

excepting employees within the jurisdiction of the following Conciliation Committees —

Agricultural Employees (State);

Cleaning Contractors (State);

Clerks (State);

Crown Employees (General);

Dairying Employees (State);

Horticultural and Garden Employees (State);

Independent Schools and Colleges (Teachers, &c.) (State);

Kindergartens, &c. (State);

Laundry Employees (State);

Retail Employees (State);

Security and Cleaning, &c. (State);

Trained Nurses, &c., Other Than in Hospitals, &c. (State).

- 2. The said committee shall consist of three representatives of employers and three representatives of employees.
- 3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales, one by the Catholic Hierarchy of New South Wales (Province of Sydney) and one by the Association of Independent Schools of New South Wales.
- 4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union, New South Wales Branch.
- 5. This order shall take effect on and from 1 September 1995.
