ORDER

The Commission orders that —

- 1. The Cement Workers, &c. (State) Conciliation Committee published 20 August 1993 (276 I.G. 339), be dissolved.
- 2. There be established a new Cement Workers, &c. (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of $\,$

All persons employed by —

Blue Circle Southern Cement Limited at Berrima, Southern Marulan, Portland, Maldon, Clyde, and Wyee;

Australian Portland Cement Limited at Kandos and Kooragang Cement Pty Ltd at Kooragang.

- 3. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.
- 4. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Chamber of Manufactures of New South Wales.
- 5. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by The AWU-FIME Amalgamated Union, New South Wales and one by the Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union, New South Wales Branch. The rights to alternate representatives shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by the Electrical Trades Union, New South Wales Branch, one by The Federated Engine Drivers and Firemen's Association of Australasia (N.S.W.), one by The New South Wales Plumbers and Gasfitters

Employees' Union, one by the Building Workers' Industrial Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch, one by The Operative Painters and Decorators' Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch, one by the Transport Workers' Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch and one by the Federated Clerks' Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch.

6. This order shall take effect on and from 24 October 1995.
