ORDER

The Commission orders that —

- 1. The Toymakers' Employees (State) Conciliation Committee published 26 March 1993 (274 I.G. 156), be dissolved.
- 2. There be established a new Toymakers' Employees (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

Employees engaged in the manufacture of toys (other than those made of sheet metal) in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna;

excepting storemen and/or packers.

- 3. The said committee shall consist of one representative of employers and one representative of employees.
- 4. The representative of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Chamber of Manufactures of New South Wales.
- 5. The representative of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The AWU-FIME Amalgamated Union, New South Wales.
- 6. This order shall take effect on and from 9 November 1995.
