ORDER

The Commission orders that —

- 1. The Chaff Cutters, Lumpers and Mill Hands (State) Conciliation Committee published 21 May 1993 (275 I.G. 165) be dissolved.
- 2. There be established a new Chaff Cutters, Lumpers and Mill Hands (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

All persons employed in or in an establishment engaged in the manufacture of chaff and chaff products, excepting persons employed in rural industries upon farms or agricultural or pastoral holdings within the jurisdiction of the Pastoral Employees (State), Dairying Employees (State), and Agricultural Employees (State) Conciliation Committees.

- 3. The said committee shall consist of one representative of employers and one representative of employees.
- 4. The representative of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales.
- 5. The representative of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The AWU-FIME Amalgamated Union, New South Wales.
- 6. This order shall take effect on and from 27 October 1995.
