## **ORDER**

The Commission orders that —

- 1. The Nurseries Employees (State) Conciliation Committee published 21 May 1993 (275 I.G. 160) be dissolved.
- 2. There be established a new Nurseries Employees (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of  $\longrightarrow$

All employees who are employed in rural industries within the meaning of section 5(4) of the *Industrial Relations Act* 1991:

- (1) in nurseries; or
- (2)at clearing, fencing, trenching, draining or otherwise preparing land for the abovementioned purposes,

within the State,

except persons within the jurisdiction of the following Conciliation Committees —

Horticultural and Garden Employees (State);

Fruit Growing Industry (State).

- 3. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.
- 4. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales.

- 5. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The AWU-FIME Amalgamated Union, New South Wales.
- 6. This order shall take effect on and from 4 December 1995.
