ORDER

The Commission orders that —

- 1. The Potato Growers (State) Conciliation Committee published 21 May 1993 (275 I.G. 156) be dissolved.
- 2. There be established a new Potato Growers (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of \longrightarrow

All employees who are employed by potato growers in rural industries within the meaning of section 5(4) of the *Industrial Relations Act* 1991 —

- (1)upon farms, or agricultural holdings or in vegetable market gardens in connection with the sowing, raising, harvesting or treating of potatoes; or
- (2)at clearing, fencing, trenching, draining or otherwise preparing land for any of the abovementioned purposes,

within the State.

- 3. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.
- 4. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Potato Growers Association of New South Wales.
- 5. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The AWU-FIME Amalgamated Union, New South Wales.

6. This order shall take effect on and from 4 December 1995.
