ORDER

The Commission orders that —

- 1. The Advertising Sales Representatives (State) Conciliation Committee published 20 August 1993 (276 I.G. 341), be dissolved.
- 2. There be established a new Advertising Sales Representatives (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of \longrightarrow

All persons in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna, employed substantially away from the employer's place of busines in soliciting orders for advertising space in newspapers, journals or periodicals, howsoever described;

excepting —
employees performing substantially clerical duties;
and excepting also —
employees within the jurisdiction of the following Conciliation Committees:

Advertising Sales Representatives (Sydney Daily Newspapers); Commercial Travellers (State).

3. The said committee shall consist of three representatives of employers and three representatives of employees.

- 4. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by The Australian Suburban Newspaper Association, New South Wales, one by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales and one by The New South Wales Country Press Association.
- 5. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the National Union of Workers, New South Wales Branch.
- 6. This order shall take effect on and from 12 December 1995.
