## **ORDER**

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Bowling and Golf Clubs, &c., Employees (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

All persons engaged as greenkeepers, ground attendants, gardeners, propagators, lawn mower and motor roller drivers and general labourers in the construction and maintenance of bowling greens and golf courses in the State of New South Wales, excluding the County of Yancowinna;

excepting employees of —

Municipal and Shire and County Councils; The Council of the City of Newcastle; The Council of the City of Sydney; Sydney Electricity; Landscape Gardeners; Master Gardeners;

excepting all persons within the jurisdiction of the following Conciliation Committees:

Club Managers and Secretaries (State); Race Clubs, &c., Employees (State); Sydney Cricket and Sportsground Trust, &c., Employees (State); Club Employees (State).

2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.

- 3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales and one by The Registered Clubs' Association of New South Wales.
- 4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The AWU-FIME Amalgamated Union, New South Wales.
- 5. This order shall take effect on and from 31 January 1996.
