BUTCHERS, RETAIL (STATE) CONCILIATION COMMITTEE

INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS COMMISSION OF NEW SOUTH WALES

Application by the Meat and Allied Trades' Federation of Australia (New South Wales Division), industrial organisation of employers.

(No. IRC 615 of 1996)

ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be a new Butchers, Retail (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

Butchers employed in shops and factories, persons employed in or in connection with the slaughterhouse of an employer killing solely for his own retail shop or shops; persons engaged in the sale of meat by retail; persons delivering meat; and carters, grooms, stablemen, yardmen, drivers of motor and other power-propelled vehicles, assistants and labourers employed in connection with any of the foregoing, or in the transport of meat solely to the retail shop or shops of the employer from an abattoir or slaughteryard in the State, excluding the County of Yanconwinna;

excepting —

Slaughterpersons and their assistants in or for bacon factories, and butchers and other persons employed in the manufacture of smallgoods, and carters, grooms stablemen, yardmen, drivers of motor and other power-propelled vehicles, and labourers employed in connection therewith;

also excepting —

Employees within the jurisdiction of the Butchers, Animal Meat — Retail (State) Conciliation Committee;

Employees of the Council of the City of Newcastle;

Employees within the jurisdiction of the Retail Employees (State) Conciliation Committee;

Employees within the jurisdiction of the Carters, &c., Wholesale Butchers (Cumberland) Conciliation Committee; and

Employees within the jurisdiction of the Carters, &c., Wholesale Butchers (Country) Conciliation Committee.

2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.

3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by the Meat and Allied Trades' Federation of Australia (New South Wales Division) and one by The Retail Traders' Association of New South Wales.

4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by The Australasian Meat Industry Employees' Union, New South Wales Branch and one by The Australasian Meat Industry Employees' Union, Newcastle and Northern Branch.

5. This order shall take effect on and from 29 March 1996.
