ORDER

The Commission orders that —

- 1. The Butchers, Wholesale (Cumberland) Conciliation Committee published 10 September 1993 (276 I.G. 542), be dissolved.
- 2. There be established a new Butchers, Wholesale (Cumberland) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

Butchers employed in abattoirs, meat works, slaughterhouses and meat preserving works, and assistants and labourers employed in connection therewith; carters, grooms, stablemen, yardmen and drivers of motor or other power-propelled vehicles employed by and working in or in connection with abattoirs, meat works, slaughterhouses and meat preserving works; persons (other than clerks and salesmen) employed in wholesale meat depots; employees engaged in or in connection with the manufacture of tripe, in the County of Cumberland;

excepting -

Boners and slicers in meat preserving works;

Slaughterpersons and their assistants in or for bacon factories;

Employees within the jurisdiction of the Carters, &c., Wholesale Butchers (Cumberland) Conciliation Committee;

Casing cleaners; and

Engine drivers, firemen, greasers, trimmers, cleaners and pumpers engaged in or about the driving of engines and electrical crane, winch and motor drivers.

- 3. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees, with a Conciliation Commissioner as Chairperson.
- 4. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales and one by the Meat and Allied Trades' Federation of Australia (New South Wales Division).
- 5. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The Australasian Meat Industry Employees' Union, New South Wales Branch.
- 6. This order shall take effect on and from 29 March 1996.
