ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Clerks (Sydney Daily Newspapers) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

Any person employed by John Fairfax Publications Pty Limited and Nationwide News Pty Limited in any clerical capacity whatsoever and without limiting the generality of the foregoing, shall include telephonists, receptionists, cashiers and persons employed on machines designed to perform or assist in performing any clerical work whatsoever.

2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.

3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by John Fairfax Publications Pty Limited and one by Nationwide News Pty Limited.

4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Federated Clerks' Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch.

5. This order shall take effect on and from 1 April 1996.
