The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Clerks, Solicitors (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of \longrightarrow

All persons employed by solicitors in any clerical capacity whatsoever and, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, shall include articled clerks, telephonists, receptionists, cashiers, messengers, copy boys and persons employed on machines designed to perform or assist in performing any clerical work whatsoever in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna.

- 2. The said committee shall consist of one representative of employers and one representative of employees.
- 3. The representative of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Law Society of New South Wales.
- 4. The representative of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Federated Clerks' Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch.
- 5. This order shall take effect on and from 1 April 1996.
