## INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS COMMISSION OF NEW SOUTH WALES

Application by the Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union, New South Wales Branch, industrial organisation of employees.

## ORDER

The Commission orders that ----

1. There be established a new Engineers, &c., Surveyors, &c. (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

All persons employed in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna, as:

- (a)aerodrome, aeronautical, chemical, civil, electrical, hydraulic, marine, mechanical, mining, production, radio, railway, road, structural, water and sewerage and wireless engineers;
- (b)aircraft building, marine and quantity surveyors and survey computers other than those coming within the jurisdiction of the Surveyors, &c. (State) Conciliation Committee; and

(c)trainees or cadets in any of the aforementioned occupations;

excepting ---

employees of the Crown; persons employed in the coal mining industry; persons employed by municipal, shire and county councils; marine engineers employed on seagoing vessels; and excepting all persons employed by ----

State Rail Authority of New South Wales and State Transit Authority of New South Wales; The Electricity Commission of New South Wales trading as Pacific Power; The Water Board; The Hunter District Water Board; The Roads and Traffic Authority; The Maritime Services Board of New South Wales; The Water Resources Commission; South Maitland Railways Pty Limited; The United Dental Hospital of Sydney;

and excepting also employees within the jurisdiction of the following Conciliation Committees —

Iron and Steel Works Employees (Australian Iron & Steel Proprietary Limited); Australian Wire Industries Pty Ltd — Newcastle Ropery; Steel Works Employees (Broken Hill Proprietary Company Limited); Special Steels and Steel Products Manufacture (Commonwealth Steel Company Limited); John Lysaght (Australia) Limited Newcastle; John Lysaght (Australia) Limited Port Kembla; John Lysaght (Australia) Limited Unanderra; Australian Wire Industries Pty Ltd — Sydney Wiremill; Australian Wire Industries Pty Ltd — Newcastle Wiremill; Tubemakers of Australia Limited, Yennora; Tubemakers of Australia Limited, Newcastle; Quarries (Australian Iron and Steel Pty limited); Quarries, &c. (Broken Hill Proprietary Company Limited); Cement Workers, &c. (State); Colonial Sugar Refining Co. Limited (Concord Works); Metalliferous Miners, &c., General (State); Metalliferous Miners, &c., General (State) No. 2; Sugar Works (CSR Limited, Pyrmont); Southern Copper Pty Limited; Incitec Pty Limited; Australian Gas Light Company (Salaried Division); Newcastle Gas Company Limited (Salaried Division); AGL Sydney Limited (Wages Division); Scientific Officers, Chemists and Chemical Engineers (State); Shipping, Engineers, Deep Sea (State); Trawlers, Masters, &c. (State); Tug Boats, Large (State);

Tug Boats, Small (State); University Employees, &c. (State).

2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.

3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by the Metal Trades Industry Association of Australia and one by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales.

4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union, New South Wales Branch.

5. Where a matter before the Conciliation Committee concerns only rates of pay or conditions of employment of employees who are members of the Electrical Trades Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch, the said Union shall have alternate nominating rights to sit as a member of the Conciliation Committee in place of the member appointed upon the joint nomination of the Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union, New South Wales Branch.

6. This order shall take effect on and from 29 March 1996.
