ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Poulterers (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

Poulterers and assistants in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna;

excepting employees of —

The Council of the City of Sydney; State Rail Authority of New South Wales; State Transit Authority of New South Wales.

- 2. The said committee shall consist of four representatives of employers and four representatives of employees.
- 3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, two by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales, one by the Meat and Allied Trades' Federation of Australia (New South Wales Division) and one by the Chamber of Manufactures of New South Wales (Industrial).

- 4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, two by The Australasian Meat Industry Employees' Union, New South Wales Branch, and two by The Australasian Meat Industry Employees' Union, Newcastle and Northern Branch.
- 5. This order shall take effect on and from 29 March 1996.
