ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Totalisator Agency Board Employees (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

All persons appointed officers by or employed by the Totalisator Agency Board under the *Totalisator (Off-course Betting) Act* 1964;

excepting employees within the jurisdiction of the Watchmen, Caretakers, Cleaners, &c. (State) Conciliation Committee and the Motor Car Washers, &c. (State) Conciliation Committee.

- 2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees¹.
- 3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Totalisator Agency Board.

4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by the Federated Clerks' Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch, and one by the Public Service Association of New South Wales.

5. This order shall take effect on and from 4 April 1996.

¹ When matters are before the Committee which affect only the interests of PSA or its members, the employee members of the Committee shall be the nominee nominated by PSA. When matters are before the Committee which affect only the interests of FCU or its members, the employee members of the Committee shall be the nominee nominated by FCU. In all other cases, the employee members shall be, as to one, the nominee of PSA and, as to the other, the nominee of FCU.
