## ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Jam, Vinegar, Sauce, &c., Manufacture (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

All persons in the industry of fruit and vegetable preserving, preparing and/or canning, candied peel makers, fruit crystallizers, fruit mince makers, jam manufacturers and persons employed in or in connection with the preserving, preparing and/or manufacture, including packing or "putting up" of jams, fruits, whether canned or otherwise, vegetables, whether canned or otherwise, crystallized fruits, fruit minces, pickles, sauce, tomato soup, chutney and wet condiments, in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna;

excepting ---

Engine drivers and firemen, greasers, trimmers, cleaners and pumpers;

Carters, grooms, stablemen, yardmen and drivers of motor and other power-propelled vehicles and extra hands employed in connection therewith;

Watchmen, caretakers and cleaners; storemen and packers; Clerks; and Employees in freezing chambers;

and excepting —

Employees within the jurisdiction of the Watchmen and Gatekeepers (Waterfront) Conciliation Committee.

2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.

3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Chamber of Manufactures of New South Wales (Industrial).

4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union, New South Wales Branch.

5. This order shall take effect on and from 17 April 1996.
