ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Jewellers and Watchmakers, &c. (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

Jewellery manufacturers, jewellers, goldsmiths, silversmiths, gilders, chasers, engravers, lapidaries and persons engaged in the manufacture or repair of watches or clocks, in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna;

excepting the employees of —

State Rail Authority of New South Wales;

State Transit Authority of New South Wales;

Roads and Traffic Authority;

The Council of the City of Sydney;

Sydney Electricity;

The Electricity Commission of New South Wales, trading as Pacific Power;

The Australian Gas Light Company;

and excepting also —

persons coming within the jurisdiction of the Crown Employees (Skilled Tradesmen) Conciliation Committee.

- 2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.
- 3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales and one by The Retail Traders' Association of New South Wales.
- 4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union, New South Wales Branch.
- 5. This order shall take effect on and from 8 May 1996.
