ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Club Employees (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of — $\,$

Employees in clubs in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna;

excepting —

Engine drivers and firemen, greasers, trimmers, cleaners and pumpers, engaged in or about the driving of engines, electrical crane, winch and motor drivers;

Persons, not including bingo callers and assistants, within the jurisdiction of the Actors, &c. (State) Conciliation Committee;

Persons within the jurisdiction of the Musicians (State) Conciliation Committee;

Persons within the jurisdiction of the Club Managers and Secretaries (State) Conciliation Committee.

- 2. The said committee shall consist of one representative of employers and one representative of employees.
- 3. The representative of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The Registered Clubs' Association of New South Wales.

- 4. The representative of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union, New South Wales Branch.
- 5. This order shall take effect on or after 22 May 1996.
