ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Plastics Industry (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of \longrightarrow

All employees engaged in or in connection with the preparation and manufacture of plastics or substitutes thereof and/or goods made therefrom and/or goods in the manufacture of which plastics or substitutes thereof are used, excluding the County of Yancowinna;

excepting —

Maintenance fitters and turners and tool makers;

Employees engaged in the manufacture of plastics, in the rubber industry or in an industry which manufactures goods by plant and equipment which are normal to the rubber industry.

- 2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.
- 3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by the Metal Trades Industry Association of Australia and one by the Chamber of Manufactures of New South Wales (Industrial).

- 4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union, New South Wales Branch.
- 5. This order shall take effect on and from 19 June 1996.
