ORDER

The Industrial Relations Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Public Hospital Nurses (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of — $\,$

Registered and enrolled nurses, trainees and assistants in nursing, and all persons employed as nurses in the industry and calling of nursing and employed in or in connection with Area Health Services and hospitals or institutions listed in the second, third and fourth schedules of the *Public Hospitals Act* 1929, other than Crown employees in the State.

- 2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.
- 3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Health Administration Corporation of New South Wales.
- 4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the New South Wales Nurses' Association.
- 5. This order shall take effect on and from 25 July 1996.
