Application by The Council of the City of South Sydney.

ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new The Council of the City of South Sydney (State) Industrial Committee for the industries and callings of —

All persons employed by The Council of the City of South Sydney.

2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.

3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, two by The Council of the City of South Sydney.

4. A representative of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Federated Municipal and Shire Council Employees' Union of Australia, New South Wales Division.

5. A representative of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, after agreement is reached between the following respondents:

- (a) The Local Government Engineers' Association of New South Wales.
- (b) The Environmental Health and Building Surveyors' Association of New South Wales.
- (c) The Electrical Trades Union of Australia, New South Wales Branch.
- (d) The Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union, New South Wales Branch.
- (e) The New South Wales Plumbers and Gasfitters Employees' Union.
- (f) The Construction, Forestry, Mining and Energy Union (New South Wales Branch).

6. If agreement cannot be reached between the respondents set out in (5) above as to the nomination of an employee representative, then the Commission member is to appoint one employee representative from those respondents.

7. Where the matter before the Industrial Committee concerns only rates of pay or conditions of employment for employees of a specific union, who are a respondent to this application, then that particular union will nominate all the employee representatives who are to sit on the Industrial Committee. That union may elect one or two employee representatives and there is to be an equal number of employer representatives to be nominated by The Council of the City of South Sydney.

8. This order shall take effect on and from 22 October 1997.
