Application by the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union, New South Wales Branch, industrial organisation of employees.

ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Animal Welfare Institutional (State) Industrial Committee for the industries and callings of —

All employees other than tradesmen and veterinary surgeons, employed in or in connection with animal welfare institutions in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna;

excepting employees within the jurisdiction of the following Industrial Committees:

Animal Feed Manufactures (State);
Carters, &c. (State);
Clerks (State);
Domestic Pet Feed Manufacture (State).

2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.

3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by the New South Wales Royal Society for Prevention of Cruelty to Animals and one by the New South Wales Animal Welfare League.

4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union, New South Wales Branch.

5. This order shall take effect on and from 25 November 1998.
