INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS COMMISSION OF NEW SOUTH WALES

Application by The Health and Research Employees' Association of New South Wales, industrial organisation of employees.

(No. IRC 3713 of 1999)

ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Ambulance Employees (State) Industrial Committee for the industries and callings of —

All persons employed by the Ambulance Employees of New South Wales in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna;

excepting persons employed in any clerical capacity within the meaning of the Clerks (State) Industrial Committee or employed exclusively as motor mechanics.

2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.

3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The Health Administration Corporation of New South Wales.

4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The Health and Research Employees' Association of New South Wales.

5. This order shall take effect on and from 15 December 1999 and shall remain in force for a period of three years.
