



Appointments of Tipstaff and Researcher to the President of the Industrial Relations Commission of New South Wales

Applications are invited for two positions, Tipstaff and Researcher to the President of the Industrial Relations Commission of NSW, the Honourable Justice Ingmar Taylor.

Position Description

The appointments will commence either in late June 2025 or late January 2026 on a 12 month contract, with the potential to extend.

The primary role of the Tipstaff is assisting the President with hearings, proofreading judgments and conducting legal research. The Tipstaff also performs a range of other court-related duties in chambers, assisting with some social functions as well as spending a substantial amount of time in court. The salary for the 2024-25 financial year is \$69,686.

The primary role of the Researcher is assisting the President with drafting speeches, policies and conducting legal research, in addition to assisting with preparing judgments. The Researcher also performs a range of other court-related duties in chambers, assisting with some social functions as well as spending time in court. The salary for the 2024-25 financial year is \$77,012.

Applications

Applicants should have strong academic records and have completed their law degree prior to beginning their appointment. Interest and/or experience in industrial and employment law is preferred.

Applications should contain a cover letter, full curriculum vitae, original or certified academic transcript, a sample of legal written work and the names and contact details of two referees. Applicants should also provide their available start date (June 2025 or January 2026).

Applications for the positions will close on Monday, 14 April 2025. Interviews will take place the following week.
