

MEMBERSHIP QUALIFICATIONS

Australia Maritime Officers' Union of New South Wales

Rule 4 - Eligibility for Membership

Part 1

The Union shall be composed of:

Masters, mates, third hands on trawlers, engineers, marine engine-drivers and employees in charge of hulks together with any other persons who are covered by an Award secured by this Union.

Part 2

The Union shall consist of:

An unlimited number of persons duly admitted to membership in accordance with these rules and who are employed as Wharf or Terminal or Depot or Lash Superintendents and/or Supervisors, Planning Superintendents and/or Supervisors (excluding planning clerks), Stevedoring and/or Cargo Superintendents and/or Supervisors, Traffic Superintendents and/or Supervisors, Wharfingers associated with the Stevedoring Industry in the State of New South Wales and such other employees who are required to control and co-ordinate Stevedoring Operations in connection with vessels allocated to them and in relation thereto the work of Foreman Stevedores, Clerks, Watchmen, Storemen, Gearmen, Waterside Workers and Mechanical Equipment Operators. The Association shall exclude from membership:

- (a) persons employed as Foremen Stevedores, Stevedoring, Terminal and Depot Managers or Directors of Stevedoring Companies, Clerks, Watchmen (including Supervising Watchmen and Head Watchmen), Storemen and Packers;
- (b) persons employed by the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales as Area Superintendents, Inspectors, Patrolmen and such other employees required to administer the regulations under the Maritime Service Act although not directly engaged in the supervision of stevedoring labour;
- (c) persons covered by the constitution rule of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales (Clerical and General Officers) Association.

Part 3

No restriction or qualification in Part 1 of this rule shall apply so as to restrict or qualify Part 2 of this rule and no restriction or qualification in Part 2 of this rule shall apply so as to restrict or qualify Part 1 of this rule.
