1. As a consequence of the merge of the Comet Express and Kwikasair Express businesses in Sydney during October of 1996 it was agreed that the Grand Total weekly rates for Contract Carriers with the following category of vehicles would be equalised as follows:

- 6. As a consequence of the agreed rates the following shall apply:
  - a) If a Contract Carrier does not perform contracts of carriage and has an absence in the nature of paid leave, the Contract Carrier shall receive amounts calculated on the hourly labour rate for each hour so absent to a maximum of eight (8) hours per day and/or forty (40) hours per week.
  - b) Where a Contract Carrier works in excess of ten (10) hours per day the hourly rates as noted in Clause 1 shall be used to calculate the fees for service payable.
- 7. The parties agree that the 15% labour component fees for service increases for Contract Carriers which constituted a part of the Transport Workers' Union 1996/96 campaign is fully satisfied by the rates noted in Clause 1 and the rates shall operate in lieu of the rates generated by the increases referred to in clause 1 and 2 of Agreement 9 of 1995 filed with the office of the Industrial Registrar on 13th April 1995 in accordance with the Industrial Relations Act 1991 as amended.
- 8. This Agreement shall operate for a period of twelve (12) months.
