BAKING INDUSTRY (STATE) CONCILIATION COMMITTEE

INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS COMMISSION OF NEW SOUTH WALES

Application by the Chamber of Manufactures of New South Wales, industrial organisation of employers.

(No. IRC 550 of 1993)

ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. The Bread Industry (State) Conciliation Committee published 31 May 1991 (262 I.G. 1173), as varied, be dissolved.
2. There be established a new Baking Industry (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

Bread salespersons and all persons engaged in or in connection with the selling and/or delivery of bread or bread rolls or baked goods (including persons so engaged who are deemed to be employees pursuant to subclause (e) of Schedule 1 of the *Industrial Relations Act* 1991), breadroom hands, and all persons employed in bakeries in or in connection with the slicing and/or wrapping of bread, loaders, grooms, stablepersons and yardpersons, employed in connection therewith in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna; and

Machine and hand bakers and assistants in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna;

excepting —

Engine drivers and firepersons, greasers, trimmers, cleaners and pumpers engaged in and about the driving of engines, and electrical crane, winch and motor drivers.

3. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.

4. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, two by the Baking Industry Association of New South Wales.
5. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, two by the Bakery Employees' and Salesmen's Association of New South Wales.
6. This order shall take effect on and from 25 March 1993.
