ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Rural Lands Protection Boards (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

All persons employed by the Rural Lands Protection Boards in the performance of work within each Board's district in or in connection with or incidental to the *Rural Lands Protection Act 1989*, the *Stock Diseases Act 1923* or any other relevant legislation, including the following:

- (a) the levying and collection of general and animal health rates in respect of rateable land;
- (b) the provision of animal health services;
- (c) the care, control and management of travelling stock reserves and camping reserves;
- (d) the care, control and management of stock watering places;
- (e) the suppression and destruction of noxious animals and noxious insects;
- (f) the erection and maintenance of rabbit-proof, dog-proof and marsupial-proof fences;
- (g) maintaining barrier fences that a Board has erected;
- (h) registering stock brand designs, earmark designs, ear tattoo designs, tail tags and other means prescribed by the relevant regulations for identifying stock on holdings.

2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.
3. The representative of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, two by the Rural Lands Protection Boards' Association of New South Wales.
4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, two by the Public Service Association of New South Wales.
5. This order shall take effect on and from 6 April 1995.
