**FRICTION MATERIALS, &c. (STATE) CONCILIATION
COMMITTEE**

INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS COMMISSION OF NEW SOUTH WALES

Application by the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union, Miscellaneous Workers Division, New South Wales Branch, industrial organisation of employees.

ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Friction Materials, &c. (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

Employees engaged in or in connection with the manufacture of brake linings, disc pads, clutch facings or other friction materials for automotive or other industrial applications in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna;

excepting —

Engine drivers and firemen, greasers, trimmers, cleaners and pumpers engaged in or about the driving of engines, electrical and oil-driven cranes (including mobile cranes), winch and motor drivers;

Carters, grooms, stablemen, yardmen and drivers of motor and other power-propelled vehicles; and storemen and packers;

and excepting employees of The Council of the City of Sydney.

2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.

3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Metal Trades Industry Association of Australia.

4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union, New South Wales Branch.

5. This order shall take effect on and from 1 September 1995.
