Application by The AWU-FIME Amalgamated Union, New South Wales, industrial organisation of employees.

ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. The Margarine Makers (State) Conciliation Committee published 20 August 1993 (276 I.G. 347), be dissolved.

2. There be established a new Margarine Makers (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

All persons employed in the manufacture of margarine in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna;

excepting employees in abattoirs, meat works, slaughterhouses and meat preserving works in the County of Cumberland;

and excepting also engine drivers and firemen, greasers, trimmers, cleaners and pumpers engaged in or about the driving of engines, electrical crane, winch and motor drivers.

3. The said committee shall consist of one representative of employers and one representative of employees.

4. The representative of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Chamber of Manufactures of New South Wales (Industrial).
5. The representative of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The AWU-FIME Amalgamated Union, New South Wales.
6. This order shall take effect on and from 24 October 1995.
