ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. The Sugar Field Workers (State) Conciliation Committee published 9 July 1993 (275 I.G. 1064) be dissolved.
2. There be established a new Sugar Field Workers (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

All employees who are employed in rural industries within the meaning of section 5(4) of the *Industrial Relations Act 1991*:

- (1) upon farms or agricultural or pastoral holdings in connection with sowing, raising, and harvesting of sugar cane; or
- (2) at clearing, fencing, trenching, draining or otherwise preparing land for any of the abovementioned purposes;

within the State.

3. The said committee shall consist of one representative of employers and one representative of employees.
4. The representative of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales.
5. The representative of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The AWU-FIME Amalgamated Union, New South Wales.

6. This order shall take effect on and from 27 October 1995.
