Application by The AWU-FIME Amalgamated Union, New South Wales, industrial organisation of employees.

ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. The Forestry Employees (State) Conciliation Committee published 19 November 1993 (277 I.G. 345), be dissolved.

2. There be established a new Forestry Employees (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

All employees who are employed in rural industries within the meaning of s. 5(4) of the *Industrial Relations Act 1991*:

- (1) in or in connection with the formation, tending, protection or regeneration of forests; or
- (2) at clearing, fencing, trenching, draining, or otherwise preparing land for any of the abovementioned purposes,

within the State.

3. The said committee shall consist of one representative of employers and one representative of employees.

4. The representative of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales.

5. Where a matter before the conciliation committee directly affects the Forestry Commission of New South Wales, the Public Employment Office shall have alternative nominating rights to sit as a member of the conciliation committee.

6. The representative of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The AWU-FIME Amalgamated Union, New South Wales.
7. This order shall take effect on and from 13 November 1995.
