CONFECTIONERS (STATE) CONCILIATION COMMITTEE

Application by the Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union, New South Wales Branch, industrial organisation of employees.

ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Confectioners (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

Confectioners, assistants and other employees engaged in the manufacture of confectionery, chocolate, cocoa, licorice, chewing gum or sweetmeat to the finished article, whether by hand or machine, in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna;

excepting —

Engine drivers and firemen, greasers, trimmers, cleaners and pumpers, engaged in or about the driving of engines, electrical crane, winch and motor drivers; and
Carters, grooms, stablemen, yardmen, and drivers of motor and other power-propelled vehicles.

2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.

3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by the Chamber of Manufactures of New South Wales (Industrial) and one by the Confectioners Manufactures of Australasia Limited (New South Wales Branch).

4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, two by the Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union, New South Wales Branch.
5. This order shall take effect on and from 17 April 1996.
