**ORDER**

The Commission orders that —

1. The Private Hospital Employees (Professional Staff) (State) Industrial Committee published 6 October 1995 (288 IG 598), be dissolved and there be established a new Private Hospital Employees (Professional Staff) (State) Industrial Committee for the industries and callings of —

Persons employed in private hospitals in the State (the term "private hospital" having the meaning provided by the *Private Hospitals and Day Procedure Centres Act, 1988*) as at 1 May 1995, excluding the County of Yancowinna, in any of the following callings or avocation, who hold qualifications appropriate to their calling or avocation or who are employed as trainees whilst pursuing a course of study leading to such qualification.

Scientific officers, Research Officers, Project Officers, Medical Officers, Medical Officers (Specialists), Speech Therapists (or Speech Pathologists), Occupational Therapists, Dietitians, Social Workers, Medical Record Librarians (or Administrators), Physiotherapists, Psychologists, Audiologists, Librarians, Welfare Officers, Nurse Counsellors.

2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.

3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, two by the Private Hospitals' Association of New South Wales Incorporated.

The following employer organisations shall have alternate nominating rights as prescribed: one by the National Association of Nursing Homes and Private Hospitals Incorporated, and one by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales.

4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The Health and Research Employees' Association of New South Wales.

Alternate representatives of employees may be nominated by The Health and Research Employees' Association of New South Wales.

5. This order shall take effect on and from 8 December 1998.
